Fly-drive Tours



Visiting Castles and Baronial Estates, 7 days

Latvia, Estonia

On this tour, you will see the cultural and historical heritage left behind in the Baltic States by rulers over the course of several centuries – six outstanding castles in Latvia and seven in Estonia, along with ancient castle ruins. The route weaves through two national parks - the Gauja National Park in Latvia and the Lahemaa National Park in Estonia. You will see the most beautiful highlands of the Baltic States, as well as the impressive seashore in Northern Estonia. You will spend time in enchanting small Baltic towns and visit important centres of culture and history, including Tartu and the two capital cities – Riga and Tallinn. Accommodations is organized at baronial estates and castles wherever its possible Full itinerary here



Walk Nature Trails, 7 days

Latvia, Estonia

The tour from Riga to Tallinn combines natural and cultural heritage and includes lovely landscapes and 15 nature trails which cross marshlands, meadows and forests along the shores of the Baltic Sea, including several protected nature reserves. Many trails are equipped with viewing towers for birdwatching. Randu meadows near Ainazi contains one third of Latvia's entire plant species. A board-walk leads through reeds to a viewing platform with views over the meadow and the sea. Saaremaa island is interesting with very different natural attractions to the mainland - dolomite cliffs, juniper heaths, a meteorite lake and rocky sea shore. The tour passes rural farms and traditional villages typical of the coastal areas. Hiiumaa island is a laid back place and retains a very Estonian atmosphere with an important bird reserve at Kaina Bay, unusual Saare Tirp as well as several small islets off its south-eastern coast. Back on the mainland, Paldiski peninsula gives a glimpse of the recent history with its former Soviet military base. Full itinerary here

Cycling Tours



Along the Baltic Sea to the Curonian Spit, 13 days

Latvia, Lithuania

This cycling route will take you from Riga along the West coast of the Baltic Sea of Latvia and Lithuania. On the way the route passes the sea resort Jurmala with 19th century wooden architecture, the picturesque Abava river valley, geologically interesting steep banks of Jurkalne, historically exiting city of Liepaja with great ambience and charming Kuldiga with the widest waterfall in Europe. In Lithuania the route goes through Palanga where Amber Museum is located and culminates at the National Park of the Curonian Spit with 60m high sand dune. Full itinerary here



Along the National Parks and Islands, 17 days

Latvia, Estonia

The route leads through the Gauja National Park. Sandstone cliffs and caves, hilly landscapes and deep forests and castles are characteristic of the park. Further on at Igate Manor stop for a lunch at their mill tavern to taste traditional Latvian food. The route turns towards the coast which belongs to continues through old Estonian fishing villages before arriving at the seaside resort of Parnu. Next is a guided wilderness day in Soomaa National Park trying old-fashioned bog-shoeing and canoeing. Further on the route will pass Pootsi with a 19th century manor and the ancient village of Varbla. Take a ferry to Muhu island and stay in the ethnographic fishermen's village of Koguva. Cycle to Saaremaa island from where you can take a ferry to laid-back Hiiumaa island for a day trip to get a feeling for the true spirit of Estonia. Back on Saaremaa explore Kuressaare with many spas. Then by bus head to Tallinn. From there enjoy a day trip to the former military base of Naissaar island. Full itinerary here
