
Regional seminars

- regular communication, development of routes and input from the expert on specification for hiking wheelchairs






Activity 1.3 Development of the accessibility solutions

Activities and next steps

All surface wheelchair accessibility in Carnikava

Purchase of <u>specially designed</u> <u>outdoor wheelchairs</u> suitable for all trail surfaces and installation of <u>universal</u> <u>design elements</u> supporting accessibility (e.g., beach access mats etc.); developing a wheelchair path.

NEXT STEPS:

- \checkmark on-site visit to inspect possible wheelchair routes 07.03.2024;
- ✓ regional seminar in Adazi for local stakeholders on inclusive and accessible tourism -14.03.2024;
- ✓ specification for hiking wheelchairs from expert based on the inspection and seminar – March 2024;
- ✓ preparation of procurement documentation April 2024;
- ✓ piloting and finalization of solution according to the piloting findings beginning of summer 2024;
- \checkmark Solution ready to use July 2024.

Impaired vision accessibility solutions in Jūrmala

2 km part of the Coastal Hiking <u>trail with</u> <u>accessibility elements</u> (e.g., info in braille, guided ropes, audio-guide with navigation instructions); <u>signs on the beach</u> to the nearest WC with baby changing table accesible also for disabled persons.





Impaired vision accessibility solutions in Jūrmala

NEXT STEPS:

- \checkmark ongoing communication with the Jurmala municipality;
- \checkmark development of the accessibility solution autumn 2024;
- \checkmark solution ready to use summer 2025.
