

Biological diversity and its protection in a rural tourism establishment

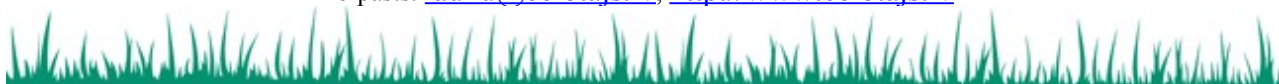
