

## BALTIC COASTAL HIKING ROUTE & FOREST TRAIL





Crossing Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania Total distance:

**3560** km / ~ 6 months to walk

The distance of 3560 km compares to:

- the length of the Appalachian trail in the USA;
- straight line distance between Riga and Morocco in Africa;
- all residents of Latvia standing in a single line, with a 2m distance.



2 km part of the Coastal Hiking trail with accessibility elements (e.g., tactile map, info in braille, audio-guide with navigation instructions).


Signs on the beach to the nearest WC with baby changing table accessible also for disabled persons.

## Scool-aged youth




#### Aim:
