THE OFFER GETTING THERE

4 days on the magnificent Via Alpina Trail, that will take you on some of the highest mountains in Julian Alps



Day 1: The transport takes you from the airport to Bohinj lake, where you take the cable car to Vogel. From there we climb on the ridge and then continue on it towards Komna. There are magnificent views of the Julian Alps and Lake Bohinj. Much of the route follows the ridge connecting the Lower Bohini mountains.

Although the tour is at an altitude of about 2,000m, the hike is not difficult and is rather pleasant. From the spacious Komna plateau we enter the stunning world of the highland lakes. Officially, there are only seven lakes, but several smaller tarns and pools can be found, depending on the time of year. The valley is also home to numerous animal and plant species. Climb up to the Na Kalu pass, below which there once was a shepherd's hut. Enter the valley and go to the hut at Dvojno jezero lake.

On the second day we leave the Triglay Lakes Valley behind. Although the route avoids the highest of the la only takes a short detour to visit them. A steep, rocky slope leads up to Hribarica, beyond which is a broad plates. popular with back-country skiers during winter. The valley is rich in fauna and flora. We will end the day in the hut on Dolić. From there we can take a short detour to the top of the highest Slovenian mountain Triglay (2864m). The return trip back to the hut on Dolić takes around 3-4h.

Day 3 stage makes a detour from the limestone mountains of the Julian Alps. Follow the comfortable mule track and climb down to the Zadnjica glacial valley. Cross the valley floor covered with meadows and forest. The Triglav National Park information centre in Trenta, where we will be staying for the night is interesting and well worth visiting.

Day 4: The last stage leads through the Trenta valley and the source of the Soca river. There is a view valley during the climb to Vršič, the highest pass in Slovenia. Cross the pass, abandon the Via Ale ail and ne old donkey path, descent towards the Kranjska Gora. On the way we will hike through forests and meadows past the Russian Chapel, the viewing point from where you can see the face of a poin the rock (Aidovska deklica). Hiking Trail - Julian Alps



THE TOUR DETAILS TURN-BY-TURN DIRECTIONS GETTING THERE LITERATURE CURRENT INFORMATION

The stage leads from Komna plateau through the stunning world of the highland lakes. Officially, there are only seven lakes, but several smaller tarns and pools can be found.

The Dom na Komni hut (1.520), lies at the eastern edge of the Komna plateau. It is one of the most frequently ited Alpine stations in Slovenia and lies at the crossroads of the most important summer and winter Alpine trails. Dom na Komni is the gateway to the Valley of the Triglay Lakes and the Realm of the Goldenhorn. According to a folk tale, the rocky Komna and the valley were once an Alpine paradise. How it ended, you will have to discover.

Komna plateau is a scarred Karstic landscape, particularly its northernmost part, also known as Zgornja Komna. The valley is also very rich in flore. At the efflux of the Lopučnica lies the southernmost and lowest-lying of the Triglav Lakes, the so-called Cmo jezero, which has a depth of 9 m. During winter, the temperature of the water falls to 4° C and in the summer it rises to 16PC. The trail enters the magical Triglav Lakes valley, where you will find rest next to the lake.

Author's recommendation

Take your time and enjoy the beauty of the lakes. But do not swim and litter the area.

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


