

The Ballic Cosstal Hiking Route, which runs along the coset of the Baltic Sea, is part of the European Iong-distance path EO. The hiking trail begins from Nide willage at the border of Libnums and Labia and ends at Talinn Port in Estonia. The strail length of the route is 1200 km, SBO km of which are in Latvia and E20 km in Estonia. The path can be travelled in both directions, as Talinn can also be the starting point.
