WQ will take notions of the sustainability of nature, and the physical abilities of his customers, as well as their social and cultural background.

WQ will give a talk to his customers on the nature of his province, its people, livelihoods, and history.





The aim of the program is to train the students to take the Nature and Wilderness Guide's Proficiency test and to create a co-operation network as early as possible during their studies.

This will help the students to create their own businesses after they achieve their Diploma.

Holders of a further vocational qualification in nature-based services have mastered the productisation process of nature-based services or products.

They know how to apply their knowledge of nature and operate in the natural environment. The have an entrepreneurial approach and know how to manage customer service situations.





Vocational skills and competences required for completion of the qualification

Wilderness and Nature Guides who have completed the competence area in wilderness and nature guide services know how to operate in wilderness and natural environments, plan and prepare their activities as a guide and guide customer groups in nature, apply their knowledge of the natural world, and see to the group's safety.





Optional exams have a variety of things guides can do in their work life.

The vocational skills required for completing the modules are demonstrated by performing practical tasks in authentic situations and work processes (demonstration of knowledge and skills). The student's knowledge and skills are assessed diversely by a teacher and a working life representative and compared to the competence defined in the qualification requirements.
