The "Green Certificate" is the Latvian national eco-label – the sign of environmental quality for rural tourism:

- All types of rural accommodation
- Small scale producers farms for tourists to visit








From year 1999 GC is supported by Ministry of Environmental protection and Environmental protection board celotajs.lv

Who is deciding on awards GC commission consist of:

- Nibistry of Environmental protection and Regional development;
- Nature Conservation Agency;
- Environmental protextion board;
- Tourism development agency;
- Green dot, Latvia;
- Technical University of Latvia;
- Latvian Fund for Nature
- Baltic Environmental Forum
- Biological angriculture organization
- Association for electric cars
- Latvian Country Tourism association
- Inspection is done by LCTA every 3 years
- Commission inspection trip 1-2x a year to selected applicants





If you're a fan of a green and healthy lifestyle, nature and the countryside environment, then "Green Holidays" will be just for you! Look for the countryside accommodations, which have received the "Green Certificate". That means that everything has been carefully considered to make sure that management of the facilities is environment friendly while ensuring comfort and amenities for guests. These buildings are in clean and orderly rural environments, and their owners have tended well to the surrounding landscape. Many of these are traditional family farms, with buildings made of and filled with materials that are natural and do not harm people's health timber, rocks and bricks, reed roofs, linen sheets and towels, as well as modern materials which reduce the likelihood of allergies. Perhaps you won't notice at first, but interior design in these buildings also is based on environmentally friendly paints and other finishing elements. Cleaning and laundry substances are also ones with ecological certification. Smoking is not permitted in any of the facilities. Many of the guesthouses offer ecologically clean and home-grown food to guests, and there are various open-air activities available such as bicycling, hiking and animal watching. Some facilities are appropriate for children, with playgrounds, pets and amenities for families with very small children. Many of the owners offer traditional saunas. Many can tell you interesting things about their surroundings. People with special needs will also feel comfortable here.
