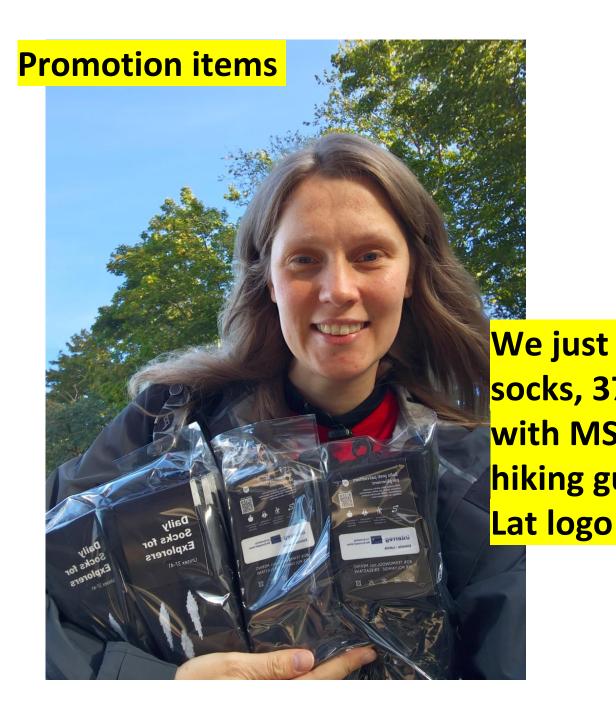

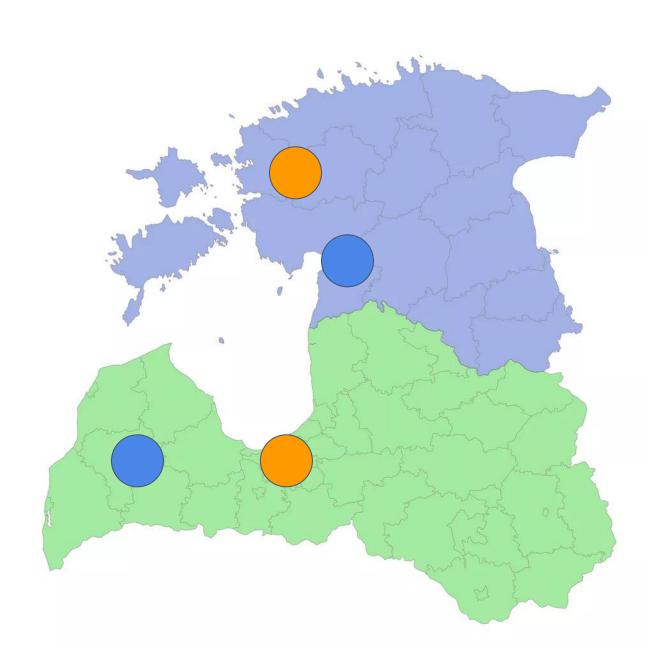

Was I nervous? Absolutely.

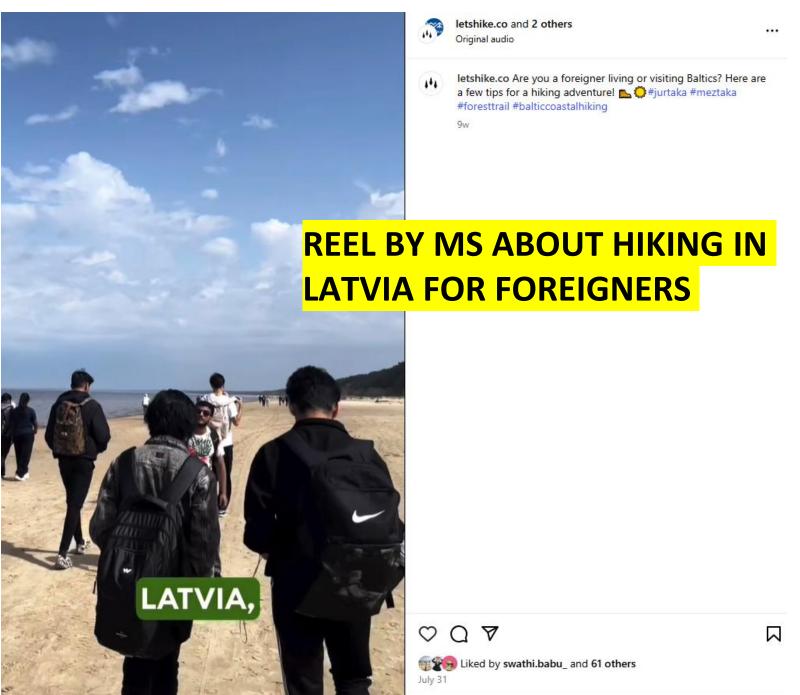
Were my feet sore? Definitely.

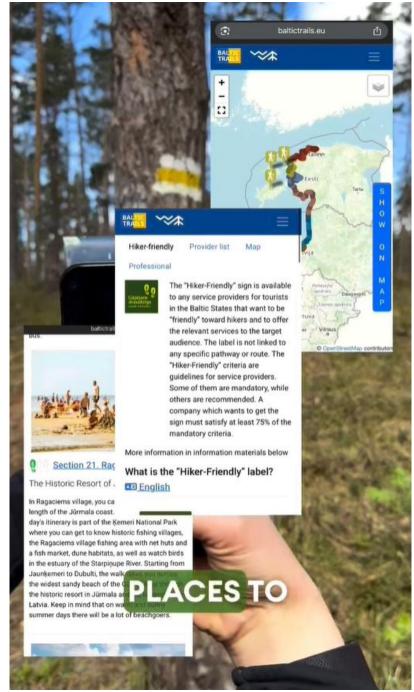
Did I lose the way once or twice? Maybe....

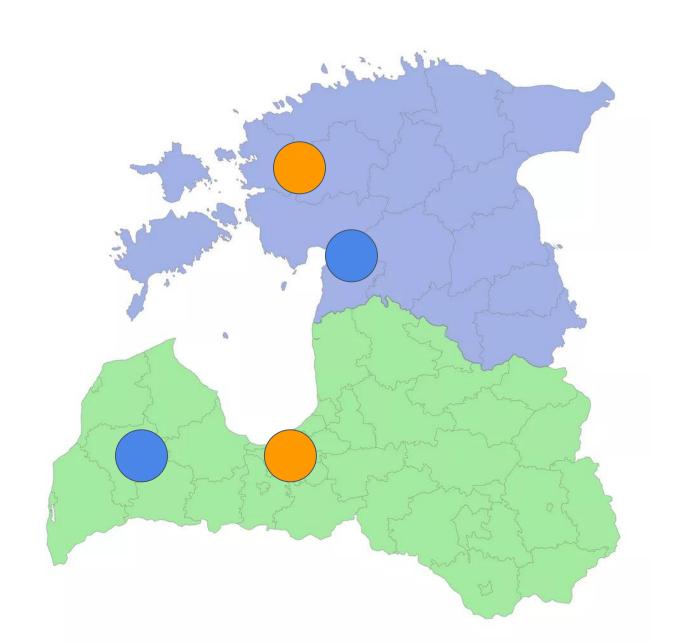
