Prepared using traditional smoking methods that reflect Baltic coastal food heritage. The sprats are cleaned by hand, lightly smoked, and preserved in highquality oil to retain a clean, natural flavour.

Pavāru Māja (Chef's House) is based in Līgatne, Latvia.

Designed as a "chef's creative workshop" for chefs, nature lovers, and creative people to gather, experiment, and share.



Which bird makes this loud, trumpeting call during autumn migration, often seen flying in V-shaped flocks?

Common crane (Grus grus)

The crane is a characteristic bird of Latvia's wetlands, common as a migratory species and a fairly widespread breeder. During spring and autumn migration, flocks can be seen in fields or flying overhead. Latvia hosts 1,000–2,500 breeding pairs, with numbers increasing in recent decades.

Who makes this sound, and in which season can you hear it?



September in Baltics is the red deer rutting season, when deer become loud and bold, roaring to challenge rivals and attract harems. This period is marked by antler clashes, complex mating behaviour, and reduced feeding, making deer easier to spot for hunters and wildlife photographers.





Can you identify these berries and think how they might be used?

Lingonberries are very common, growing in dry or moderately moist pine forests, transitional bogs, and along forest edges. They are picked both wild and, valued for their tart flavour, widely used in jams, baked goods, and as a traditional side for **meat dishes**.

Which of these melodies is played on the *Kokle*, the traditional musical instrument in the Baltics?







The kokle is a traditional Latvian plucked string instrument, part of the Baltic psaltery family alongside the Lithuanian kanklės, Estonian kannel, and Finnish kantele. Known since at least the 17th century, it is carved from wood, strung with metal strings, and played by plucking to create soft, resonant tones.


Kokle playing is recognised as a traditional cultural value and is included in the Latvian Cultural Canon.




